If you discover that your card has been lost or stolen, and it's **during UECU's regular business hours** (Weekdays 8 A.M. - 5 P.M., Wednesdays until 3:30 P.M.), contact a UECU Member Service Representative at **800.288.6423**.

If your card is lost or stolen after UECU's regular business hours or while traveling internationally, contact Visa Global Customer Assistance Services.
